

Minimum Wage Increase for Student Assistant II, III & IV Effective Jan. 1, 2018

Changes to the California minimum wage law will increase the minimum hourly rate to \$11, effective Jan. 1, 2018. The minimum wage will continue increasing annually, until it reaches \$15/hr. on Jan. 1, 2022. At UC Davis, the changes effective on Jan. 1, 2018 will only affect the Student Asst. II, III and IV titles as outlined below. Please share this information with your impacted Student Assistants.

HR is working with Central Payroll to implement a “mass change” in the PPS payroll system to bring all impacted titles up to their new minimum rates by Jan. 1, 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The salary increases will be a departmental cost.
